

'Mann sublet Punjab's governance to Delhi CM'

Shiromani Akali Dal (SAD) president Sukhbir Singh Badal on Monday said Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann had sublet governance of the state to Delhi CM Arvind Kejriwal.

Addressing party workers during the party's campaign for the Sangrur by-poll in Dirba Assembly constituency, for party candidate Kamaldeep Kaur Rajoana, Badal said Mann and the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) had befuddled the people of the state in the same way as done by Captain Amarinder Singh earlier during the 2017 Assembly polls.

"Don't think that women will get Rs 1,000 per month as promised (by AAP). The promised 300 units of free power will also not be given. Even schemes initiated by former CM Parkash Singh Badal including the 'aata-



daal' scheme, shagun scheme and the old age pension have been disrupted. This AAP government has given nothing and has taken the state to the brink of disaster with the total breakdown in the law and order," he added.

The SAD chief said Mann abandoned the people of Sangrur after taking over the reins of the state as the Chief Minister. He said immediately after becoming the chief minister, Mann failed to conduct a thanksgiving tour of his

constituency as well as the Sangrur parliamentary seat which had elected him to the Lok Sabha twice.

"No development work has been initiated in the Sangrur parliamentary constituency and even ongoing works have

been stopped," he added.

Appealing to the people to support the candidature of Rajoana, the SAD president said "A vote for Rajoana is a vote to free all Bandi Singhs (Sikh prisoners) who are in jail even after completion of their life sentences. I appeal to Punjab to unite as one and elect Rajoana to the Lok Sabha to free Sikh detainees and reunite them with their families,".

Badal claimed Rajoana's immediate family was also a victim of police atrocities with her elder sister and brother being killed and their house being burnt. "This happened despite the fact that Rajoana's father had served in the army and had fought for the country," he added.

Rajoana is the sister of Balwant Singh Rajoana who is convicted in former Punjab chief minister Beant Singh's assassination case. She is the joint candidate of the SAD, Bahujan Samaj Party (BSP) and panthic (Sikh religious).

Sangrur bypoll: AAP deploys six ministers and MLAs for campaign

In a bid to win the first election after the party's landslide victory in Punjab Assembly polls, the ruling Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) has deployed six Cabinet ministers to campaign for its candidate Gurmail Singh from the Sangrur Lok Sabha by-poll on Monday.

The Cabinet ministers including Brahma Shankar Jimpa at Sangrur Assembly constituency, Kuldeep Singh Dhaliwal at Dhuri, Gurmit Singh Meet Hayer in constituency Barnala, Harpal Singh Cheema from Assembly constituency Dirba, Harbajan Singh at Malerkotla, Dr. Baljeet Kaur at Bhadaur and Laljit Singh Bhullar at Lehra have launched the campaign for the party candidate today.

Gurmail Singh is seeking a vote on the name of the development works and pro-people initiatives taken by the Chief Minister-Bhagwant Mann-led government in almost three months.

Earlier, the AAP's Members of Legislative Assembly (MLAs) also started canvassing in



favour of its candidate from the constituency, which is a stronghold of AAP since 2014.

AAP candidates along with different MLAs held door-to-door meetings with supporters and also addressed 'nukad meetings' in villages and towns in the constituency on Monday.

The AAP candidate along with MLAs including Jagdeep Kamboj Goldy, Jagroop Singh Gill, Harmeet Singh Pathan-Majra, Gurmeet Singh Khudra, Fauja Singh Sarari, Jagdeep Singh Kaka Brar, Davinderjit Singh Laddi,

Aman Arora and Tarunpreet Singh Sond campaigned in the constituency.

The incumbent Chief Minister Mann remained a two-time member parliamentary from this seat in 2014 and 2019. This seat fell vacant after Mann resigned as MP following his triumph from the Dhuri constituency in the state Assembly elections.

AAP's candidate Gurmail is a post-graduate and before entering politics as a full-time politician, he was a teacher and taught children at various schools till 2018.

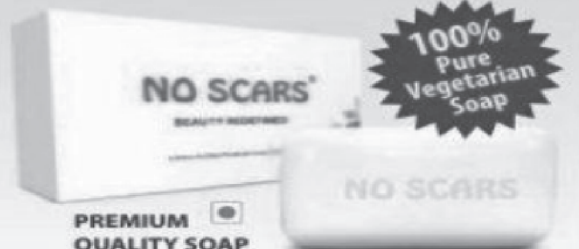
